Our resources are for students working in the areas of the plant identification, pruning, treatment of weeds, pests and diseases, turf management and more. Our resources are for RTOs who train and assess the skills of individuals who work in the amenity horticulture industry.

AHC30116 Certificate III in Agriculture

These training and assessment resources develop the general skills and knowledge of people working in or intending to work in agriculture. Students select a pathway where their job focus would align to cropping or livestock or, in the case of mixed farming enterprises, both cropping and livestock.

AHC31016 Certificate III in Parks and Gardens

Our resources provide students with general skills and knowledge required to work in parks and gardens set aside for recreational purposes. Our wide range of units available allow the RTO to choose different streams within this qualification.
